SNOWPLOW OPERATIONS

Snowplow operations start when snow reaches depths of 3" on roadways in Arnold, West Point, Glencoe, Avery, Railroad Flat, and Mountain Ranch. Camp Connell and Dorrington operations start with 2" of snow on the roadways.

Route Priority:

- Main roads providing access to state highways and collector routes
- School bus routes

The creation of berms are unavoidable due to turning limitation of plows and must be removed by the resident.

Parking of vehicles on the County maintained right-of-way during snow removal is prohibited. CHP will cite and/or remove any such vehicle at the owner's expense. Driving closely behind a snowplow is discouraged. Snowplow drivers make frequent stops and back up maneuvers.

Calaveras County Department of Public Works staff work diligently to complete snow removal operations as quickly and safely as possible.

Plan ahead with emergency kits and extra supplies.
