1. Recent Activity

A house was tagged on Wikami. The house was sprayed with white paint as well as a lot of the surrounding trees. We offered a \$250 reward for information leading to an arrest. We haven't received any information.

2. Guest speakers:

- Fox Security presented information about home security systems. They are a local company and are now using a new system that reports disturbances wirelessly. Burglars have learned that most burglar alarm systems report a disturbance over the phone line, so before breaking in, they cut the phone line. Fox now has enough repeaters installed between here and Arnold so that they can get a wireless report regardless of your cell coverage.
- Discussed security cameras and their installation so that your neighbor's privacy is not breached.
- The cameras they install are infrared and do not need lighting to get pictures.
- One of the cameras can be pointed so that if there is a vehicle in the driveway, it can take a picture of the license plate.
- Fox is a local business with offices on Moran Road in Arnold.
